

RULES — "AMERICA"

Shuffle and deal 7 cards to each player. Place the deck face down in the center of the table with top card face up, alongside, to start a discard pile.

The object of the game is to build a 7 letter word, in the hand, preferably the name of a city or a state in America, a president or AMERICA.

Play starts to the left of the dealer. Each player picks up a card from either the deck or discard and discards a card from his hand or the card picked up. The Flag card is used for any letter. (The card of Rules may also be used for any letter, if desired.)

The first player to build a 7 letter word, lays down his hand and play stops. Scoring as follows: 7 letter word—100; 7 letter city—200; 7 letter state—300; 7 letter president—400; "America"—500. Players then able to form words of less than 7 letters get 10 points for each letter.

If played progressively with four at each table the two highest move up after four deals.

ALPHABET RHUMMY

Remove Flag card, deal and play as above, excepting that instead of making up 7 letter words in the hand, words of at least four letters are laid on the table, face up, which can be built up at either end or altered, by substitution, at either end.

Each such play must complete a word. The first player to lay down all cards wins the hand and is credited with one point for each card still in the hands of the other players.
