

# Directions for QUIZZLE

## The Puzzle-Quiz Game

### EQUIPMENT:

Quizzle Board: 4 Series of Quiz Sheets. 1. U.S. History and Government. 2. State Capitals. 3. World Geography.  
4. General Information Forty-eight Answer Blocks for each Quiz Sheet.

### METHOD OF OPERATION.

1. Open Quizzle Board. Put Quiz Sheet face-up in Frame.
2. Break Answer Blocks apart, shuffle and place answer-side up on table. (Answer Blocks for each series of questions are the same color as the Quiz Sheet, i.e.,-Blue, Pink, etc,)
3. Fit Answer Blocks to questions on the Board.
4. When all questions have been filled in with answers, close Quizzle Board and turn over.
5. Open . . . Remove Quiz Sheet.
6. If all questions have been answered correctly, you will find a complete full-colored picture! Any piece out of place in the picture indicates a wrong answer.

### ALTERNATE METHODS OF PLAY:

Played as outlined above, QUIZZLE is an ideal solitaire game. It may also be played competitively by 2-3-4-6 or 8 players by dividing the questions as follows:

**FOR TWO:** Use vertical columns. Each player answers all questions in each alternate row, from top to bottom.

**FOR THREE:** Use vertical columns. Each player answers all questions in two adjoining columns, from top to bottom.

**FOR FOUR:** Use horizontal columns. Each player answers all questions in two adjoining rows across the board.

**FOR SIX:** Use vertical columns. Each player answers all questions in a single row, from top to bottom.

**FOR EIGHT:** Use horizontal columns. Each player answers all questions in a single row across the board.

Players answer questions in turn, one at a time, until the QUIZZLE BOARD is filled. When Board is reversed, players score 1 point for each correct answer.

**NOTE:** QUIZZLE may also be used as a straight Jig-saw Puzzle, fitting pieces of each picture together, with no reference to the Quiz Sheets.
