

BUTTERFLY STOP.

The game may be played by any number of persons.

The cards must be thoroughly shuffled, and dealt one at a time to each player, commencing at the left of the dealer, until the entire pack has been *evenly* distributed among the players. In case there are any cards remaining after an equal distribution they are to be placed in the centre of the table (*face up*).

The players place the cards which have been dealt *face downward* upon the table in front of them. Beginning at the left of the dealer the players in regular order place the top card of their hand in the centre of the table (*face up*).

Whenever a Butterfly Card is played, the one playing it exclaims "Butterfly Stop!!" and is entitled to all the cards that have been played, but in case he omits to do so before the next card has been played, the cards must remain on the table, and the game proceeds in the regular order.

If by chance the first card played at any stage of the game is a Butterfly Card, the player is entitled to it provided he exclaims "Butterfly Stop!!"

If at the commencement of the game any odd cards have been placed in the centre of the table, the player who plays the first Butterfly Card as above provided, is entitled to them the same as if they came from the hands of the players.

Whether a Butterfly Card removes the cards on the table or not, the player next in order leads in continuing the game.

In case the last cards played are *Flower Cards*, they go to the one who has properly played the preceding Butterfly card.

At the end of the game the player holding the greatest number of cards is entitled to five points. The one holding the Butterfly Card, named "Regal Silver Wing" is entitled to three points, and all the other Butterfly Cards count one point each.

The maximum number of points for each game is nineteen.
