# FIVE IN A ROW.

The object of each player is to arrange his five men on the crosses in a row - in line from end to end, side to side, or diagonally from corner to corner of the board, in a straight line.

The one who is to first place a man upon the board is left to the option of the players. Then each places a man alternately on any cross they choose until all the men are on the board.

After all the men have been placed, and provided a row or line has not been formed, as above, the players each in turn move a man from cross to cross on the red lines only, and continue in this manner until a row of men is completed.

No jumping is allowable, and all moves must be made on the red lines.

The game is won by the player who first succeeds in completing a row with his five men, or by the player who by so placing his men blocks his opponent so as to make another move impossible.
