

# HIDDEN AUTHORS

Any number of persons may play the game of Hidden Authors.

Select one among the company to act as reader for the first game. The one at the left takes the place of reader in the second game.

The reader places the entire number of cards together, face downwards, upon the table in front of him. He turns up one at a time, not allowing any of the players to see the face, and reads the question at the bottom of the card as it is, or prefaces the same with any language he may choose.

He asks the first question of the one on his left, and if that player fails to give the author's name after the lapse of one minute the next one in order has the chance, and so on until the player *at the right* of the reader is reached. If one of the company of players gives the correct answer (the author's name) he is entitled to receive the card from the dealer.

The second question is put to the second player at the left of the reader, and ending with the first player at his (the reader's) left, the third question to the third player at the left of the reader, and ending with the second player at his (the reader's) left, and the game is continued in this manner until all the cards have been read. If no one among the company gives the proper answer after each one has had the opportunity, the card is retained by the reader and counts for him.

The player having the greatest number of cards at the end of the game is the winner.

The allowance of one minute in which to give the answer may be varied at will.
