WORD GAME

The best way to play a NEW game is to read the rules thoroughly before commencing play.

OBJECT: Players try to arrange the eight lettered dice to form the most advantageous number of words possible.

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: Two or more; also can be played solitaire.

HOW TO PLAY: Before rolling dice from the Shaker, each player must call for his "DOUBLE-POINT" bonus (See below). After rolling the Dice, the player tries to arrange all eight, or as many of them as possible, into words. No Proper Nouns, Foreign Words or Abbreviations are permitted. Try to use words with the greatest point value. Play continues clockwise until one player scores more than 400 points.

COMPETITIVE ROCK AND ROLL: One player rolls the dice. The combination is written down, and all players in turn try to score as many points as they can with the combination. There is a three minute time limit for each player.

SCORING RULES: "DOUBLE-POINT" Bonus — Before rolling, player calls "ROCK" (high) or "ROLL" (low). If the total point value of all eight dice is over Fifteen points, it is considered as high; Fifteen points or less is low. The player who calls his score correctly is entitled to DOUBLE his total score of words formed on that roll.

"Rock and Roll" symbols can be used in place of any letter. However, they have no point value, either in scoring or for determining the High and Low total.

No more than one "Rock and Roll" symbol can be used in any one word.

WORD SCORING:

C₂ O₁ R₁ M₁ ★ All mixed words (red and black) score face value.

M₂ 0, S, T, * All one color words (red or black)
- face value, plus ten points.

T, 0, R, M,

Using all eight letters—face

value plus thirty points.

★ Using all eight letters in one

R₁ O₁ T₁ A₁ T₁ I₁ O₁ N₁ word—face value plus fifty points.

EXTRA POINT SCORING: You will notice that each letter has a point value. Using only one-point letters or two-point letters, it is possible to make words of various lengths. These carry an extra point value as follows:—

S₁ T₁ A₁ R₁ E₁
