### DIRECTIONS FOR PLAYING

# BIBLE GIRLS

- 1st. The game is made to be played as the old game of "Authors"—two or more being able to play, four or six making a good number.
- 2nd. There are 56 cards in the set, making 14 books of 4 cards each. Each card and book has its number in the upper left hand corner.
- 3rd. Shuffle the cards carefully, dealing out to each player an equal number, one at a time. If two or four only are playing, it is better for each person to have a dozen cards, and the balance placed in the center of the table, from which each person may draw one card in his turn, after failing to secure the card asked for.
- 4th. The name of the card is represented by the name of a Bible girl, or a statement of fact concerning a girl, printed **above** the picture on the card, in the right hand corner.
- 5th. If a player holds one (or more) cards belonging to a book, he should try and secure the others needed to complete the same, which he will lay aside, the object of the game being to see who can secure the largest number of books.
- 6th. In calling, always ask for either the card having the name of a girl, or a statement of fact concerning the girl, printed **under** the picture on the card.
- 7th. The person on the left of the Dealer begins the game, asking from any of the players some card to complete or help to complete a book. If the player called upon holds the card asked for, he must give it up, and the player receiving the same puts it with the other cards of the same book. If it completes the book, he lays it aside and continues to ask for cards from any of the players until he fails to secure one, when his turn ceases, and the next player at his left takes up the game, and so on in turn until all the books are completed, when the player having the largest number of books is winner.
