

DIRECTIONS

for playing the game of

SEASON

— * —

The game may be played by two, or any number of players, not exceeding four.

The object of the game is to form the following words by letters on block with each player holding enough blocks to form one word. The words are:

SPRING SUMMER AUTUMN WINTER
SEASON

The game consists of 30 blocks, each block having a letter thereon, and the blocks have the following letters thereon:

A E G I M N O P R S T U W

TO PLAY

Place all of the blocks face down on the table and shuffle the blocks thoroughly and then place all of the blocks in one straight row.

The person to the left of the shuffler then draws two blocks from one end of the row, and then each player to the left continues to draw two blocks until each has six blocks and these are held in the palm of the left hand in two rows of three blocks each.

Starting with the first player to draw the two blocks, each player then draws one block from the same end of the row and matches this block with the blocks in his hand to try to form one of the above words, discarding one block with each play and placing it at the opposite end of the row.

This is continued until some player completes one of the above words, and the first one to complete a word is the winner of the Game.

RULES

1. Every player should memorize and keep the above five words in mind while playing.
2. Don't let any player see or know your hand or see the discarded blocks, which always place face down on the table without any player seeing the letter discarded.
3. The winner always shuffles the blocks and the first person to the left of the shuffler begins to draw the blocks.
4. Count -- Double points for SEASON.

The blocks may also be used to play a game called

NINE HIGH

With the numbers on the blocks, playing same as Black Jack.

The players drawing one block at the first play, and one or more, not exceeding two at the second play, and not holding more than three blocks at any time.

Any player matching two blocks with same letter and numbers call Dang, which is the same as Black Jack in the game of Black Jack.

The points of ten, twenty, or thirty are the dead hand for this game.
