



How to Play LIBERTY FLAG GAME 3 to 6 Players

This game consists of 35 cards: One special card, THE STATUE OF LIB-ERTY, and 34 other cards with flags of different nations. These 34 flag cards are stumbered in pairs from 1 through 1.7

numbered in pairs from 1 through 17.

Shuffle the cards and deal one at a time, until they are all distributed.

Then each player picks up his cards, matches as many pairs by number as possible and lays them face up in front

of him on the table.

The dealer plays first by drawing one card from his right hand neighbor, and if possible, matches another pair. Then the player from whose hand the card has been drawn, in turn draws a card from the player on his right, also trying to match another pair. Thus the play con-

tinues until all pairs have been matched.

At the end of play, whoever holds the special STATUE OF LIBERTY card

is the winner.

NOTE: When playing examine all the flags and learn to recognize them. Also notice that each card tells the location of the country, the capital city, the area and population.
