DIRECTIONS

The object of the game is to snap the jacks onto the board in such a way as to obtain the highest score.

Two, three or four can play the game.

The jacks are divided evenly among the players and the box containing the game is placed in the centre of the table.

The players take turns snapping their jacks onto the board. The pointed end of the jack

is placed in the hole of the snapper. The snappers are placed any agreed distance from the board, with the hole turned toward the player. Each player in turn snaps all his jacks onto the board. He then totals his score and removes the jacks before the next player takes his turn. A jack must land in a hole in order to score.

The player making the highest score wins the game.

If preferred, instead of dividing the jacks, each player can use all the jacks, totaling his score and then passing the jacks to the next player for his turn.
