DROP-'EM AND WOOD PILE PICK-'EM UP

HOW TO DROP EM



1. Gather the sticks in the right hand; place them so that they point vertically and quickly pull your hand away. The sticks will fall into a heap.



HOW TO PICK EM UP

- 1. Singly, pick the sticks up being careful that the OTHERS do not move.
- 2. As long as NO OTHER STICK MOVES, you may continue to play. If one stick moves you are through and the player at your left takes his turn.
- 3. Both hands may be used. The PRESIDENT may be used (if you get into difficulty) to flick a stick which is lying on several or to part two that are too close together. BUT NO OTHER STICK than the PRESIDENT.
- If a stick moves for any reason while you are PICKING EM UP, you lose your turn.

4. If a suck moves in	Sticks	Color	Each counts
SCORING	1 PRESIDENT	Black	20 points
	5 VICE-PRESIDENT	Blue	10 points
	5 GOVERNOR	Green	6 points 5 points
	15 SENATOR S CONGRESMAN	Red Yellow	4 points

- 1. The score is kept for each turn and totaled for each game. The game is automatically won by the player with the highest score. Also, at the end of the game, add to the Winner's score the difference between his or her score and that of each other player.
- 2. If you are crafty and pick up all the sticks from your first throw, you take another turn. This is done over and over, or until you move a stick.
- 3. Every player has his own bundle of sticks.
- 4. If α CONGRESSMAN, α SENATOR and α GOVERNOR is picked up in this respective order, the COUNT IS DOUBLED.
- 5. You must not stand up or move from your place at the table while the game is on.
- The number of rounds to be played are decided before you start the game.
