—For countless years boys and girls all over the world have played and enjoyed TIC-TAC-TOE. It has lived so long because it is so simple, yet if a number of games are played in succession any boy or girl who doesn't pay close attention will suddenly find he has lost a game.

RULES

Player selects either a cross or circle for his mark. He must keep this mark throughout the play. The object is to get three marks in a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally so that a straight line can be drawn through them (see illustration). Loser has first turn in new frame. First play must be in a different section in each frame. Keep score by pages.
