

## DIRECTIONS. CITIES OF OUR COUNTRY.

- 1. This game may be played by any number of
- 2. The distributor may be determined by any method that is agreeable to all the participants.
- 3. One card at a time shall be distributed from left to right until each has received three cards.
- 4. Every question on each card is answered by the name of the city at the top of the card.

  5. The player at the left of the distributor always begins the game:—Suppose there are four players. D is the distributor and A is on his left; A asks B, at his left, any question from any card in his, A's, hand; if B answers correctly he receives the card from A, and lays it fare down on the table to his, B's, credit; if B fails to answer, A puts the question around to the left until it is answered, or all have had a trial; the player answering in turn gets the card; more than one trial is not allowable; if no one can answer, the questioner, A, keeps the card to his credit, but must never answer his own question: B then takes his turn at asking, and begins at his left with C in the same manner; C then asks D, and each takes his turn, regardless of who answers the questions; whenever the questioner loss a card to the answerer, he always draws another from the top of the pack, so that each player shall always hold three cards; when a player wins five cards he has a book; the number of books required to win a game depends on the number of players; or, each player may count his cards separately, and the one having the most, wins; the game may also be played in partnership.
