OBJECT OF THE GAME: The first player to cover all the numbered spaces in any one row on any card wins. The player who does this should annouce "Lotto,". If the players decide to prolong the game, they can make up the rule in order for a person to win, all numbers on any one lotto card would have to be covered.

RULES:

One person is elected Leader of the game and **she** allows the players to select three lotto cards. He shuffles the deck of numbers and then places it up side down, that is, with the numbers facing the table. He turns over the first card of the deck calling the number. The players who have that number, place the wood or paper counter on it. If a number is called, which none of the players have, the Leader simply continues to the next card. The whole process is continued until one of the players announces "Lotto"..
