

Memory Verses.

No. 1 may be memorized in study classes.

5. Sword Drills.

Mix cards well. Draw one. Announce reference or write it on black board, as II Tim. 2:15. Contest to find it first, in Bible, class rising or numbering 1, 2, 3, etc., as they find it. When several have found it, read it in concert. A credit of 10 to the first and 5 to the second finding it may be given seeing who can win 50 or an agreed number first.

6. Key Verses.

Give reference and beginning of each verse and drill until class can give the verse from reference alone as II Tim. 2:15. At first a partially correct repetition may be accepted, later requiring an exact wording.

### Game Number 5

#### DIRECTIONS FOR PLAYING

1. Shuffle cards thoroughly. Give each player four cards, placing remainder on table to draw from.

Genesis, (first book of O. T.) Malachi, (last book); Matthew and Revelation are leading cards. Whoever has one of these (preference is given to Genesis and Matt.) may play first. The books must be played in their order, forward on Gen. as Ex. and backward on Mal. as Zech., etc. No. 1 plays as long as possible, then draws. If card drawn plays, No. 1 proceeds to play again. Any player who has no card to match "passes" and draws. Game is to play out cards first.

If order of Bible Books is not familiar, at first each player may use index of Bible.

## II. Suggestive Thoughts.

Shuffle well. Place cards face downward on table. No. 1 draws top card, asks question No. 1 on card. If No. 2 answers correctly he wins the card. If he cannot answer, No. 1 places card on bottom of pile and No. 2 plays.

Game is to win 10 cards first.

### 2. Book Divisions or "Authors."

Name on cards under (2) is the name of this card to be used in playing a game of Book Divisions like "Authors," all the Books of one division making a book. Certain cards as "Revelation" constituting a book of itself. The different groups or "books" counting as many points as there are books in the group. Add points to see who has won. The number of cards making the group is given at top of card.

Pentateuch or Law Books. G., E., L., N., D.

O. T. Historical Books, J., J., R., 1st and 2nd S., 1st and 2nd Ki., 1st and 2d Ch., E. N., E.

O. T. Poetical Books, J., P., P., E., S-S.

Major Prophets. I., J., L., E., D.

Minor Prophets. (On card.)

New Testament

Gospels. M., M., L., J.

History Book. A.

Paul's letters (On card)

General Letters. J., 1st and 2nd P., 1st, 2nd and 3rd J., J.

Prophecy Book. R.

3. Book Contents.  
Play as game 1, asking question 3, only all the questions under 3 must be asked before card is placed under pack.

4. Accurate Location.

Play as game 1, asking question 4. Answer must be given in this exact wording. Ex.—  
"Genesis precedes and Leviticus follows Exodus." (Consult Bible index for disputed locations.)
