PYTHAGORAS (545 B.C.) a Greek philosopher and geometrist who is most famous for the theorem that in a right triangle the square of the hypotenuse is equal to the sum of the squares of the other two sides. This is also known as the 47th proposition of Euclid's Elements.

INSTRUCTIONS

This booklet contains 179 puzzles that can be made from the seven plastic pieces. All seven pieces must be used in each design and they must form exactly to the design as shown. All 179 puzzles are possible. Keep a record of the solutions as they are solved.
