

INSTRUCTIONS FOR Commandment and Beatitude Game

(In any Educational game, parents or teachers playing with the children adds greatly to the interest.)

For playing, shuffle cards. Leader may hold cards, asking questions of each in order. The one answering correctly winning the cards. If incorrectly leader gives answer and places card on bottom of pack.

When all cards have been won, the winner is the person having the highest number of credits.

OR, Play as above placing cards face down on table, each player drawing a card in turn, asking the question agreed upon.

Question No. 1, on card is used in playing "Topical" Commandments and Beatitudes.

IDOLATRY

1. What is the Second Commandment about? (Idolatry.)
2. Repeat the Second Commandment.

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them; for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. Ex. 20:4-7.

3. N. T. I Cor. 10:14. I Jno. 5:21.
4. Ex. 34:14. Deut. 5:8-10.



Question No. 2. Plays "Perfect Memorizing," by requiring exact wording of longer Commandment in italics, and later when agreed upon the entire commandment.

OR, Cards may be distributed equally, each keeping cards in order, asking question from top card, game being to secure an agreed upon number of cards.

SPELLDOWN. Choose sides. Leader asks questions alternately of each side, until question is correctly answered, giving card to winner. When cards are all given, see which side holds the most.

BIBLE DRILLS No. 3, on cards gives place in New Testament where the thought of Commandment is given, and the places in Old Testament where thought of Beatitude is expressed.

Use texts as Bible Reading, Sword Drills, etc.
