Bunco is played with 3 dice. Four people to a table, opposite being partners. One of the players at head of Bunco table rolls one dice for trump which is announced to the other tables, and play starts at once.

For each trump turned up one point is counted, except when 3 trumps at one time turns up, then 23 points is counted. If 3 of any other number turns up, 5 is counted. Player continues rolling dice until no more trumps appear.

Head table will call Bunco as soon as one set of partners at that table make 23 points. Players at other tables are allowed to make as many points as they can until Bunco is called.

High score partners are declared winners, and their score cards are punched.

If a tie occurs at any table, players at that table continue to roll dice until same has passed once around table; highest score partners being declared winners of that inning.

All winners move up to the next highest table, except at Bunco table where the losers move to the last table.

25 are the maximum number of games played.
