RULES FOR PLAYING THE GAME OF

WONDERFUL JOE-

FOR 2, 3 OR 4 PLAYERS

IMPLEMENTS consist of 24 cards divided into 6 books of 4 similar cards each.

THE OBJECT of the game is to see which player can collect most books of eards.

TO BEGIN. Shuffle the cards and deal around face downwards.

The players then search their hands for complete books of 4 like cards and place them before them on the table.

The first player then calls upon any other player for a card that he needs. As long as the player obtains the cards called for, (which the other player must give up if he has) he continues calling. When the player fails to get the card called for the turn passes to the player last called.

TO WIN. The player who gets most points wins. The number on each card is its value.
