**DIRECTIONS.**

Besides making use of this as a geographical map, a very interesting game may be played with the cards as follows:

The cards are placed face down in a pile and well mixed. The players decide upon a boundary line which they will take as their standard for the game. This may be one of several, as, for example, the States bordering upon the Atlantic, Gulf, Pacific, British America, Mississippi River, Ohio River, the Lakes, etc.

The players in turn draw a card from the pile and place it in its proper position on the table to form the map. The person playing the greatest number of cards representing land bounding upon the boundary selected, wins the game.
