A game for any number of players

The players decide who shall play first, second, etc. and play in that rotation throughout a game.

The first player places all the balls in the center of the board and taking the top places its spinning end in the center circle and gives it a twirl.

After the top has stopped spinning the score is taken according to the numbers beside each hole in which a ball rests; and the play passes along to the next player.

The player first scoring 300 points wins the game.

Spinette may also be played by the players agreeing upon a certain number of turns each, and the player having the highest score at the end of the agreed number of turns wins the game.

In either method the odd colored ball counts double.
