

EAL the cards face down, one at a time till all are distributed. The cards are valued according to the numbers at the top of each. It will be seen the three Historical Cards have no value in playing. The player at the left of the dealer begins by playing any card he may have, the others play in turn and the one playing the card of the greatest value, takes up all the cards played and places them in a pile before him. The winner each time leads off on the next round. At the end of the game, the player whose pile of captured cards is of the greatest value wins.
