MOVIES" wins the game. This space must be reached by an exact throw. That is, if a player reaches space 103 he may only move forward if he throws an M or if he throws an M O, the latter of which would exactly take him in in that instance. If he reached space 101 and threw M, O, V, I, the four letters would take him exactly in, WINNING THE GAME.

PREMIUM: If a player throws three or more first letters, namely, M, O, V or M, O, V, I, etc., in addition to the play on this throw he is given an extra throw as a part of one and the same turn.

HE utensils include one large dice cup, six movie dice, and four playing pieces. The players throw the dice to see who starts the game, the one who throws the largest number of single letters spelling the word "MOVIES" (printed on the dice), starting the game, the turn to play always going to the left. The letter M must appear to make any count, as it is the first letter in the word "MOVIES". If O also appears the player moves two spaces; if V appears, three spaces, and so on. Only one move can be made for each letter of a kind; in other words, to move six spaces it would be necessary for all six letters M, O, V, I, E, S to appear at one throw.

To PLAY: shake all the MOVIE dice and throw them on the table. The play is made according to the number of letters that appear forming the word "MOVIES."
These letters must appear in order to count.

Example: If a player throws "MOIEES" he would move two spaces only, because he got an M and an O but no V. If he had thrown "MEVISS" he could only move one space, as M was all he threw in consecutive order. (To have the V count, it would be necessary for an O to appear in this throw.) In other words, the letters must appear in consecutive order to count. If no Misthrown, no play can be made, as M is the first letter and must always appear to count one space. If a player threw all six letters, M, O, V, I, E, S, he could move his playing piece six spaces. Only one throw of the dice is permitted each player in turn.

The player whose piece first reaches the space marked "QUEEN OF THE

ANOTHER METHOD. Throw all the dice; if you do not throw an M you have no move and turn passes to the next player. Should you throw an M, an M-O, an M-O-V, etc., you leave these on the table and throw the remaining dice, and if you throw a letter or letters which are in consecutive order to the letter or letters already thrown helping to form the word MOVIES, you leave these also and shake the remaining dice, continuing till you fail to throw a consecutive letter; then move your piece one space for every consecutive letter thrown.

The Premium (having an extra throw) may be eliminated in this method, if thought desirable.
