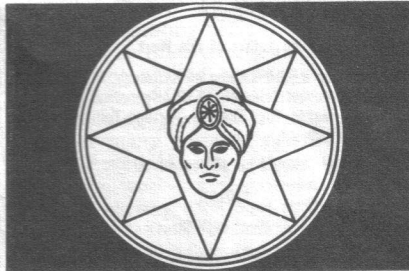

INSTRUCTIONS

Since the beginning of Time, man has been trying to delve into the future. It is only natural that we should all want to know what our destiny may be.

The ancient Chaldeans and Egyptians used a series of Cards, fashioned from stone, designating certain characters that they saw in the Stars. The fame of their predictions spread throughout the then civilized world. Cards have been used for divining purposes ever since.

After many years of research into the various methods and systems used by the Ancients, and more modern gypsies, I have conceived this new system of Fortune Telling with a deck of cards based upon the ten planets and the twelve signs of the Zodiac.

Whether you are interested in these Fortune Telling Cards from an entertainment standpoint, or whether you actually believe the predictions obtained thereby is a personal matter. I trust that

you may find these new Astrological Cards both amusing and helpful. I make no claim as to the reliability of the predictions obtained with these cards and I recommend them for entertainment purposes. This form of entertainment has always been fascinating, especially when the system used is broad enough to permit the readers to let their imagination have a wide range.

IT IS THEREFORE NECESSARY IN ORDER TO ELIMINATE THE POSSIBILITY OF MAKING MISTAKES, TO PRACTISE DEALING AND SHUFFLING THE CARDS SEVERAL TIMES, ACCORDING TO INSTRUCTIONS, BEFORE STARTING TO READ.

You will note that on one side of the Cards are designs or pictures for the various signs and planets of the Zodiac, together with the interpreted meanings of these designs for Fortune Telling purposes. On the back or printed side of each Card, you will note the astrological

readings for the various Signs, Planets and Houses of the Zodiac.

When telling Fortunes, use the picture side of the Cards. When giving an astrological reading use the printed side of the Cards.

To simplify matters, we will presume you are reading the Cards for yourself. When reading for someone else, have them shuffle and cut the Cards and you deal them off according to the following instructions:

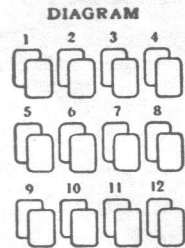
Instruction No. 1

**For Telling Fortunes Using the
Picture Side of the Cards**

First shuffle the Cards thoroughly and MAKE A SILENT WISH. Place the deck on the table and cut the Cards into three piles, towards yourself, with your left hand. Then stack towards yourself into one pile.

Pick up the deck and deal out twelve cards, faces up, (starting with

the upper left hand corner), in three rows of four Cards each. Then in the same manner, place one card from the pack on each of the Cards already dealt out, as per diagram:



The remaining eight cards may now be set aside, as you have no further use for them. You are now ready to start the first step in reading your Fortune.

(IF THE RED MARS APPEARS IN THE LAY-OUT, YOUR WISH WILL COME TRUE!)

NOTE :

If the RED MARS should appear with your Sign of the Zodiac or the Sign of the Person for whom you are reading, it indicates the receipt of some very good news in the immediate future.

On the other hand, if the BLACK MARS appears with your Sign of the Zodiac, it is a warning to avoid extravagant urges and all speculative ventures during the following week.

While it is difficult to ascertain the exact time when predictions may take place, it is presumed that when reading a person's fortune, the events indicated may happen within twelve days or twelve weeks from the time the fortune is being told.

The two cards in the upper left-hand corner are supposed to represent the first day or first week; the second two cards the second day or second week, and so on. In other words, the events

predicted for the complete reading may occur during the following twelve days or twelve weeks. While you may come across many exceptions to this rule when giving a reading, this is the time limit generally indicated by the arrangement of the twelve separate signs.

The predictions obtained by the cards appearing side by side may happen at any time during the following twelve weeks, but the approximate time may be ascertained by the rows in which the cards appear. If the RED MARS and the BLACK MARS appear side by side in the first row, the change should occur within the month. Then again, if the RED MARS should appear in the first row and the BLACK MARS appears horizontally next to it in the second row, the change may occur within the next two months, etc. For further explanation, see pp. 9 & 10.

To start reading the Cards, begin with the two Cards in the upper left hand corner. Be sure to replace each two Cards in their original position as

you will have further use for them. Combine the readings of each two Cards where plausible. Otherwise, read the Cards separately.

Example: If the FAVORABLE SUN, which "denotes good health or a speedy recovery from illness," should appear with the LIBRA card which reads "receipt of a letter or message," you would interpret these two cards to mean the receipt of a letter or message telling about a speedy recovery of someone who has been ill. However, should the FAVORABLE SUN appear with the SCORPIO card which "denotes a considerable sum of money or the receipt of a costly gift," these two Cards combined do not make a plausible reading. You should therefore interpret each Card separately, as follows: You are about to receive a costly gift or perhaps a considerable sum of money and you will hear about the speedy recovery of someone who has been ill.

As another example, we will take the UNFAVORABLE MOON which "denotes gossip, secrets or intrigue" appearing with the AQUARIUS card which "indicates an unexpected journey or the renewal of a friendship." In order to combine these readings, you could say that the person is about to take an unexpected journey and on this trip, they should beware of doing anything that may cause gossip or slander.

Since the AQUARIUS card also "denotes the renewal of a friendship" and the UNFAVORABLE MOON also tells one "to beware of jealous friends or intrigue," this can also be interpreted as follows: You are going to renew a friendship that may cause some jealousy. It is therefore advisable to be on your guard against intrigue.

By carefully studying the meanings of the various Cards, you can readily combine their interpretations into an interesting and comprehensive fortune.

After you have read the twenty-four

Cards and their meanings, you have completed the first part of the reading.

YOU ARE NOW READY TO START THE SECOND PART OF THE READING.

Place each two cards in the lay-out directly on top of each other. Look at the twelve cards on the upper pile and see if there are any of the same planets side by side. For example, a BLACK SUN beside a RED SUN, or a BLACK MOON beside a RED MOON, etc.

THE PRINTED MATTER ON THE CARDS IS NOW IGNORED.

The following table is the literal meanings for the same Planets appearing side by side, either HORIZONTALLY OR PERPENDICULAR.

MOONS side by side: Mean radical changes in the home.

SUNS side by side: Dealings with lawyers, legal matters or officers of the law.

VENUSES side by side: New friendships or associations.

MERCURY'S side by side: Change of affections.

JUPITERS side by side: Change of location or environment.

MARS side by side: Change of business or financial conditions.

SATURN'S side by side: A trip to another State.

NEPTUNE'S side by side: Change in personal plans coming as a sudden surprise.

URANUS'S side by side: Unexpected news.

PLUTON'S side by side: Secret changes.

After you have read the predictions of the planets appearing side by side on the top pile, remove the top twelve cards and note what planets appear side by side on the bottom twelve cards, and interpret their meanings accordingly.

This completes the second part of the reading.

NOTE

The same cards appearing on top of each other are not considered side by side.

Now you may separate all the GREEN, RED and BLACK CARDS in the lay-out.

If you have seven or more RED CARDS, this indicates that your future hopes, ambitions or romantic affairs are favorably aspected.

If you have seven or more GREEN CARDS, this indicates that you can expect improvement in your financial affairs.

If you have five or less BLACK CARDS, this indicates that your domestic or personal difficulties will soon be overcome.

If you have five or more BLACK CARDS it is a warning to guard

against emotional upsets and domestic arguments.

This completes the Fortune. With a little practice, you will learn how to interpret the different combinations of cards (so you can give an intelligent reading.

DO NOT READ CARDS FOR THE SAME PERSON MORE THAN ONCE IN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS.

LUCKY NUMBERS: If you desire to ascertain your Lucky Numbers, shuffle and cut the cards three times as instructed. Deal off as many Cards as you desire Lucky Numbers. Only the Lucky Numbers appearing on the picture side of the cards are used.

Instruction No. 2

How to Give an Astrological Character Reading Using the Twelve Signs of the Zodiac

If you desire to learn the outstanding characteristics of any individual, refer to the Card pertaining to their birth-date. Then by noting the Ruling Planet for their Sign, you can readily ascertain the dominant personal tendencies of the individual by comparing the positive aspects of the Favorable Ruling Planet and the negative aspects of the Unfavorable Ruling Planet with the characteristics shown for the Sign of the Zodiac in which the person was born.

The reading matter on the Cards representing the Signs of the Zodiac is for giving an astrological character analysis and is not used when ascertaining the planetary influences in the various Houses.

For example. To read a person's character analysis born on April 10th, you would remove the ARIES card, since ARIES governs all persons born between March 21st to April 20th. You would then remove the Favorable and Unfavorable MARS, since MARS is the Ruling Planet for ARIES.

All persons born in any given Sign are said to possess the characteristics indicated for that Sign. If their ruling Planet was in favorable aspect at the time of their birth, they will have developed the positive tendencies of their sign. However, if their Ruling Planet was in unfavorable aspect at birth, they may have developed the negative tendencies of their sign.

By reading the sign card and the

favorable and unfavorable ruling Planet Card, any individual can soon ascertain whether their Ruling Planet was in favorable or unfavorable aspect at the time of their birth, by noting the number of positive and negative tendencies in their character. If the positive tendencies are in the majority, then they were born with their Ruling Planet in favorable aspect. However, if their negative tendencies are in the majority, then they were born with their Ruling Planet in unfavorable aspect.

These Cards give you a short synopsis of all the signs of the Zodiac and the Planets used in Astrology. With a little study, you will be able to readily understand the fundamental principles upon which a Horoscope is based. For more complete information read Simple Lessons in Astrology.

SIMPLE LESSONS IN ASTROLOGY

The Zodiac is a circle divided into twelve equal parts. The twelve parts are called the twelve Houses of the Zodiac. Each House is represented by a Sign and each Sign has a Ruling Planet.

The following are the Houses together with the Signs they represent:

THE FIRST HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by **ARIES**. This House influences early environment and personal affairs. It has to do with the personality and the disposition of an individual. It represents the purely physical side. It is therefore regarded as the House of Personality.

THE SECOND HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by **TAURUS**. This House influences money, finances, liberty and movable effects. It covers possessions, investments and financial

prospects. It is therefore regarded as the House of Finance.

THE THIRD HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by **GEMINI**. This House influences short journeys, brothers, sisters and letters. It also influences the intellect and sub-conscious mind. It has to do with communications, education, studies and correspondence. It is therefore regarded as the House of Mentality.

THE FOURTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by **CANCER**. This House influences personal possessions, the end of life, real estate and the Mother. It also affects matters pertaining to estates and inheritances. It is therefore regarded as the House of Home Life.

THE FIFTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by **LEO**. This House influences sex instincts, social pleasures, children and avocations. Amusements, pleasures, social life and

speculation are also influenced by this House. It is therefore regarded as the House of Sensations.

THE SIXTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by VIRGO. This House influences health, servants, clothes, food, physical requirements and personal comforts. It is therefore regarded as the House of Health.

THE SEVENTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by LIBRA. This House influences partnerships, agreements, marriages, exchanges and the public in general. It is therefore regarded as the House of Union.

THE EIGHTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by SCORPIO. This House influences legacies, divorces, deaths, losses and all matters pertaining to the dead. It affects the spiritual side of the person. It is therefore regarded as the House of the Psychic Mind.

THE NINTH HOUSE of the Zo-

diac is represented by SAGITTARIUS. This House influences religion, philosophy, long journeys, publications, legal matters and the higher mind. This House affects the higher mentality, professional ability and scientific thoughts. It is therefore regarded as the House of Philosophy.

THE TENTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by CAPRICORN. This House influences profession, honor, fame, dealings with superiors and social standings. It also influences the business ability and occupation of the individual as well as the general status of his environment. It is therefore regarded as the House of Advancement.

THE ELEVENTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by AQUARIUS. This House influences hopes, wishes, relations, societies and friends. It is principally concerned with social matters, friendships and associates. It is therefore regarded as the House of Associations.

THE TWELFTH HOUSE of the Zodiac is represented by PISCES. This House influences confinement, inhibitions, limitations, restraints, sorrows, privations and institutions. It affects such matters as imprisonment and reverses. It is therefore regarded as the House of Inhibitions.

The Following Are the Signs of the Zodiac and What They Signify

ARIES—is represented by the symbol of the Ram. ♈ The Ruling planet is MARS. Persons born in this sign are intellectual, ambitious, idealistic, enthusiastic and self-centered. They are known to be natural leaders and full of schemes of grandeur. The sign of ARIES rules the head and face.

TAURUS—is represented by the symbol of the Bull. ♉ The Ruling Planet is VENUS. Persons born in this sign are practical, persistent, cautious,

unshaken by adversity or difficulties, slow but sure, gentle when unprovoked but furious when angered. The sign of TAURUS rules the neck and throat.

GEMINI — is represented by the symbol of the Twins. ♊ The Ruling Planet is MERCURY. Persons born in this sign are enthusiastic but changeable, somewhat inconsistent, rather impatient when inactive and possess intellectual ideas. This sign rules the arms and shoulders.

CANCER — is represented by the symbol of the Crab. ♋ The Ruling Planet is the MOON. Persons born in this sign are ambitious, sympathetic, receptive, impressionable, sensitive and easily influenced by their surroundings. This sign rules the breasts and stomach.

LEO—is represented by the symbol of the Lion. ♌ The Ruling Planet is the SUN. Persons born in this sign are

ambitious, independent, fearless and cannot be driven. They are always ready with dictatorial advice. This sign rules the breast, heart and spine.

VIRGO—is represented by the symbol of the Virgin. ♍ The Ruling Planet is MERCURY. Persons born in this sign are scientific, practical, critical, judicial and humane. They are great champions of reform. The sign rules the abdomen.

LIBRA—is represented by the symbol of the Scales. ♎ The Ruling Planet is VENUS. Persons born in this sign are spiritual, scientific, imaginative and original. They weigh their problems rather carefully and have a well-balanced nature. This sign rules the kidneys and loins.


SCORPIO—is represented by the symbol of the Scorpion. ♏ The Ruling Planet in MARS. Persons born in this sign are ambitious, aggressive, subtle,

fearless and possess a rather powerful nature, whether for good or evil. This sign rules the sex organs.

SAGITTARIUS—is represented by the symbol of the Archer. ♐ The Ruling Planet is JUPITER. Persons born in this sign are jovial, generous, very athletic, ambitious and energetic. They are quick thinkers and act upon impulse. This sign rules the thighs and hips.

CAPRICORN—is represented by symbol of the Goat. ♑ The Ruling Planet is SATURN. Persons born in this sign are prudent, cautious, practical, not easily discouraged and dignified. This sign rules the knees.

AQUARIUS—is represented by the symbol of the Water-bearer. ♒ The Ruling Planet is URANUS. Persons born in this sign are spiritual, scientific, philosophical, rather conservative but progressive. This sign rules the calves and ankles.

PISCES—is represented by the symbol of the Fishes.  The Ruling Planet is **NEPTUNE**. Persons born in this sign are idealistic, emotional, self-sacrificing, very fond of dumb animals and loyal to their friends. This sign rules the feet.

*The Following Are the Planets
and What They Signify*

THE SUN—Ruler of **Leo**. Center of our Solar system and the Giver of Life. Rules the individuality. In favorable aspect it influences ambition, loyalty, faithfulness, honor and stands for dignity. But in unfavorable aspect it influences. Vanity, egotism, arrogance, hate and domineering. The Sun takes about 365 days or one year to make a complete circle of the Zodiac.

THE MOON—Ruler of **CANCER**, symbolizes the forces of life and rules the personality. In favorable as-

pect it influences idealism, reception, grace, adaptability, domestic and maternal instincts. But in unfavorable aspect it influences weakness, changeability, inconsistency, laziness and unreliability. The **MOON** makes a complete transit of the Zodiac approximately every twenty-eight days. Therefore the aspects of the **MOON** to the individual are highly changeable, since it is the fastest moving planet in the Zodiac.

MERCURY—Ruler of **GEMINI** and **VIRGO**, is known as the God of Knowledge and rules the mind and memory. In favorable aspect it influences ingenuity, intellect, versatility, and concentration. But in unfavorable aspect it influences carelessness, cunningness, artfulness, shiftlessness and shrewdness. **MERCURY** makes a complete circle of the Zodiac in an average of sixty-six to one hundred days.

VENUS—Ruler of **TAURUS** and **LIBRA**, is known as the Goddess

of Love and Beauty. In favorable aspect it influences peace, happiness, affection and harmony. In unfavorable aspect it influences love of ease and pleasure, immodesty, self-indulgence and thoughtlessness. VENUS makes the complete circle of the Zodiac in about 225 days.

MARS — Ruler of ARIES and SCORPIO; is known as the God of War and Center of Divine Energy. In favorable aspect it influences courage, activity, adventure, fearlessness and executive ability. In unfavorable aspect it influences boldness, audaciousness, destructiveness and selfishness. MARS makes the complete circle of the Zodiac in about twenty months.

JUPITER — Ruler of SAGITTARIUS, is known as the God of Fortune. It is the royal planet and is said to control the Divine Wisdom. In favorable aspect it influences generosity, benevolence, happiness, devotion, philosophy and sincerity. In unfavor-

able aspect it influences wastefulness, extravagance, impatience and lawlessness. JUPITER makes the complete circle of the Zodiac in twelve years.

SATURN—Ruler of CAPRICORN, is known as the God of Time. In favorable aspect it influences steadfastness, vitality, justice, prudence and action. In unfavorable aspect it influences hypocrisy, discontentment, deceit, avariciousness. It takes SATURN twenty-nine and one-half years to make a complete circle of the Zodiac.

URANUS—Ruler of AQUARIUS, is known as the God of Air. In favorable aspect it influences originality. It is rather an eccentric planet that controls all unpredictable activities. In unfavorable aspect it influences peculiarities, unexpected and unforeseen happenings. It also shows obstinacy. It takes eighty-four years for URANUS to make a complete circle of the Zodiac.

NEPTUNE — Ruler of **PISCES**, is known as the God of the Waters. It is the Spiritual Awakener and gives inspiration and idealism. In favorable aspect it is inspirational and idealistic. In unfavorable aspect it influences indolence, deceit, disrespect and shiftlessness. It takes **NEPTUNE** one hundred sixty-four years to make a complete circle of the Zodiac.

PLUTO—This planet was recently discovered. Much research work is still in progress concerning its influences. Its vibrations are problematical and seldom used in connection with general Horoscope readings.

Reading these Astrological Cards should not be confused with casting a Horoscope, although the same Signs and symbols are used in both. When casting a Horoscope, the actual position of the planet is ascertained by mathematical calculations and therefore the results are accurate. Whereas, in

dealing the Cards, the Planets are placed in the Houses but a matter of chance and have no bearing upon the actual position of the Planet at the time the fortune is told. Naturally, the predictions obtained with this deck of Fortune Telling Cards are purely accidental and should not be confused with the exact Science of Astrology.

These Cards were originated and produced for your amusement and enjoyment by **ZOLAR** who makes no claim to the authenticity of their predictions. Through their constant use **ZOLAR** hopes to familiarize you with the various Signs and Planets of the Zodiac, so that you may more readily understand the fundamental principles used in Astrology.
