## "BIG APPLE"

## DIRECTIONS

The "BIG APPLE" game can be played by two, three or four players.

To play, separate the cut up apples and numbers and place the pieces face up into the lid of the box. The first player spins the big apple and after it stops, he scores the amount to which the stem of the apple is pointing. He then picks up a corresponding number from the lid of the box to indicate his score.

The following players proceed in the same manner, in rotation. When one's score adds up to 100, he takes a piece of apple in exchange for his numbers and keeps it on the table in front of him. If a player spins and the apple stops with the stem pointing to the number 100, which is the "BIG APPLE", the player picks a piece of apple for his score and is entitled to an extra spin.

The game is then continued in the same manner until one player has completed his apple. The first player completing his apple is the winner.
