INSTRUCTIONS FOR "FAN-TEL"

- To get the best results from your "FAN-TEL" it is important that you follow these instructions:
- 1 Find the metal peg in the box. Hold peg upright.
- 2 Mix up the blades in the box (be sure blades are upside down, picture end hidden downward in the box).
- 3 Draw hand in circles over blades in box and MAKE A WISH!! Silently repeat your wish as you draw out 14 blades — ONE AT A TIME. Be sure you have the correct psychic impulse before selecting any particular blade.
- 4 Slip these blades with picture side FACE DOWN-WARD on the peg.
- 5 With the thumb on the head of the peg, press the peg between the first two fingers, grasping the blades firmly between thumb and first two fingers. Open into fan shape with picture side toward you.
- 6 Wave the fan in front of your face, and say

"FAN-TEL" Fan Good Luck To Me, "FAN-TEL" Tell Me What You See.

7 — You may now read "FAN-TEL" — Group readings of two or three or four blades tell separate parts of the story. Refer to Legend Sheet for meanings. STUDY THESE GROUP READINGS VERY CAREFULLY. You will find a story being woven for YOU — in a pattern that ONLY YOU WILL UNDERSTAND.

8 — When you have finished with this, select the blade in which you are most interested, and count that stick as NUMBER ONE. Count to SEVEN — to the right — always return across the face of the fan counting from left to right. The first and seventh blades always have a direct bearing to each seventh blade. Continue counting One to Seven — ALWAYS USING THE SEVENTH BLADE AS NUMBER ONE. You will come back to the blade you started from, and this gives you SEVEN HIGH POINTS, which completes your
