

BOUNCE BALL GAME

Place the game in the center of the table or upon any flat surface. The object of the players is to bounce the ball through the ring B, at the top of the game in one bounce. If the player fails to bounce the ball through the ring it is a miss, and the player at the right tries next. If this player fails, the one next tries and so around the circle.

Whenever the ball bounces through the ring it counts.....10 Whether it rolls of or stats on the board and does not settle in a hole or depression.

If the ball after bousing through the ring settles in the holes in the circle it counts5.

When a player bounces the ball through the ring and the ball settles in a depression which has a black number the amount is written on the score card and counted in the player's favor. But if the ball settles in a depression which has a red number it is counted against the player and is deducted from the total score.

Bounce Ball can be played by as many at one time as desired.

Players may set the score at 100, 200, or 300. The first player reaching the required figure wins the game.

NOTE. unfortunately the directions are glued to the lid. Illustrations seem to be very good, game appears to be 1900---1920. Children are pictured in that period clothing.
