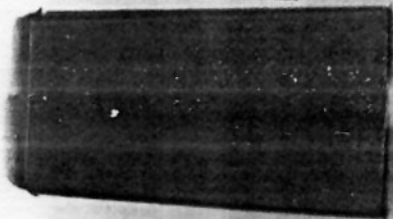


PETER RABBIT'S PUZZLE GAME



This is a game for 2-4 players, aged 3 years and upwards.

Contains:- 4 jigsaw cut playing boards, dice and shaker. Each playing board features a Beatrix Potter character - Peter Rabbit, Mr Jeremy Fisher, Jemima Puddleduck and Mrs Tiggywinkle.

The object of the game is to be first to piece together and complete your Beatrix Potter character.

Here's how to play the game:-

Each player chooses a playing board, and places the pieces in front of them. Any boards not being used should be put back in the box.

Play starts with the youngest player and continues in a clockwise direction. You need to throw a one to start, and if you don't throw a one then play passes to the next person. If you have thrown a one, then you can start making up your board, choosing one of the pieces with the number 1 on it.

After you have thrown a one and started your board, then on your next throw you can make up your board by picking the pieces that match the numbers thrown on the dice.

Remember that each player only has one throw at a time, whether or not you get a number you want.

The first to complete their board is the winner.
