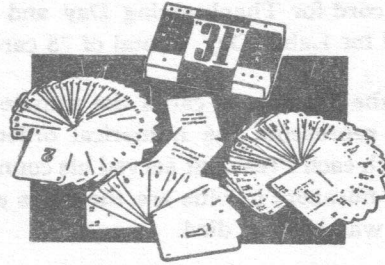

3 Games in One

The deck of "31" consists of the twelve cards representing the 12 months of the year, each numbered 1 in red. There are 31 days in most months, these are represented by thirty more cards numbered from 2 to 31. As 31 men have served as President of the United States (Grover Cleveland being 22nd and 24th President) 31 more cards are added. There is also one card for Thanksgiving Day and one card for Labor Day, a total of 75 cards.

On the Presidents' cards the number in red represents the numerical order in which each President served his country. The numbers in blue are the dates each one was born or died.

Month 31—Assists in teaching the number of days in each month. Also the

months of the year and their rotation and the months in each quarter.

Addition 31—Improves the ability of all players in addition and rapid calculation of small sums of 1 to 31.

Solitaire 31—Is a game almost everyone knows and now plays with a regular deck of playing cards, but play with the "31" deck produces and permits new ideas and manipulations. One, two or more can play this game as far as points are concerned,—each playing the game alone, and the total score of each player determining the winner. By subtracting each score from the highest score, the extent of the winner's superiority over each of the other players is decided.
