**INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLAYING**

**HAPPY FAMILIES.**

- 1.—This Game may be played by any number of persons. The players sit round the table and the cards are dealt singly, face downwards, to the players in rotation.
- 2.—Each player takes up his cards and arranges them in families; if he holds a complete family he places them face downwards on the table in front of himself.
- 3.—The player on the dealer's left commences the Game (which is to complete as many families as possible) by asking any one of the players for any card he requires towards completing a family. If the card is forth-

coming he may ask the same or any other player for another card, and keep on until the player asked has not the required card and replies "Not at home." The turn for asking passes to this player, and so on round the table.

- 4.—A player may not ask for any card unless holding one of the same family himself.
- 5.—Any player asked for a card and holding it must deliver it.
- 6.—When the families are all completed the player holding the most families asks any other player for a whole family, and if the player asked does not hold it he replies "Not at home," and the right to ask passes to him. The Game proceeds in this manner until one player gets all the families, thus winning the Game.
