



THE GAME

OR CIRCLES.

A NEW METHOD OF DISSECTION.

RULES FOR PLAYING.

This Game may be played by either two, three or four persons.

The counters must first be divided among the players, who form a pool, by each paying one or two counters (as may be agreed upon) into it.

Each player takes a card of such color as he pleases. The Circles are then placed in the bag, and either one of the players draws them out, one by one. As fast as the circles are drawn out, they are given to the players who hold the cards of corresponding colors. The player who fills up his card first, is the winner, and takes the pool, and holds the bag the next time.

This may be repeated until one of the players obtains the whole number of counters.

The cards and circles which are not needed (when there are less than four players) should be laid aside.

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
