AUCTION BRIDGE LAWS

1927

By L. C. Vogel, Bridge Whist Editor of "The Log," City Club, St. Louis.

In Auction Bridge with four players, two play as partners against the other two. Unless otherwise agreed it is customary to cut for partners. After rards have been shuffled, each player turns up a card, and those who turn up the two highest cards are partners against the two lowest. The player drawing the highest and has first deal and choice of seats. If a player draws more than one card, he must draw again. At end of card subber, players again cut for deal and pariners.
