



**"TELLING TOMMY"
CARD GAME DIRECTIONS**

Deal five cards to each player and lay the surplus pack face downward in the center of the table. The player at the left of the dealer then begins to play by calling from any other player for an answer card to any question card which he holds in his hand, such as "Mary, who brought the first cows to America?" If the answer card is held by the player called upon he must surrender it to the caller and repeat the answer. The caller then asks another question. When the caller fails to get the answer to his question, he lays the question card face up on the table and draws one card from the top of the pack, and the call passes to the left. When player does not have answer card called for he says "Ask Dad." When a player does not have a question card in his hand he draws from pack on the table until he gets one.

Any player on his turn to play may pick up any question card laying face up on the table if he has the answer card by repeating the answer.

Any player having or drawing the "Tell Tommy" card places it face up on the table with all the question cards in his hand and says, "Tell Tommy." Any player having the answer card to any question must give it to the player. The player keeps the "Tell Tommy" card until all the questions which he held when he received the card are answered, then the "Tell Tommy" card is placed in the middle of the pack on the table thus giving another player a chance of drawing it.

In case all cards are exhausted from a player's hand he draws two cards from the pack on the table.

The player having the most "books" (a question and its answer) at the end of the game is the winner.
