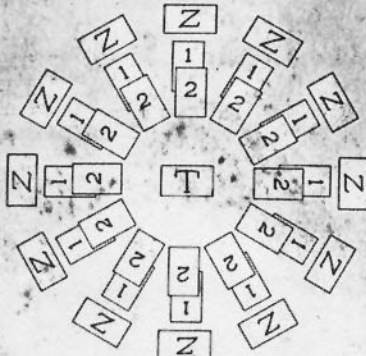


**DIRECTIONS**  
FOR  
**Zodiac Circle Horoscope Game**

Shuffle the 12 Zodiac cards and place them, face down, in a large circle. Shuffle the remaining cards. Place two for each Zodiac  
(OVER)

card; and one, in the center of the layout, for a Time card. (See diagram.)

Turn up the Zodiac cards until you find the card which includes your birth date. Read your horoscope from it. The Time card and the two cards between it and your horoscope card contain your reading. Turn up the Time card ("T" in the diagram), which also bears a message indicative of the future, and read the *top section only*; read the *middle section only* of your message card marked "2"; and read the *bottom section only* of number "1."

A wish may be made before the cards are run, and if a Lucky Star appears in the lower right-hand corner of one or more of your message cards it is a favorable sign.

To ask Time, consult the Time card. If, for example, it bears the number "5," and your birthday is June 23, write down 5 (the Time card number), write 6 (for June, the sixth month) and write 2 and 3 (the figures in your birth date). Add them. The result (16) has more than one figure, so add the 1 and 6 together and you will find the Time to be 7. If the Time card number is in a Square, the time is in Years; in a Circle, Months; the number alone, Weeks. If the card is marked "X," the time is indefinite.

You may run the cards for any person, present or absent, whose birthday you know.
