Because of its unique construction "Gee Wiz" has been acclaimed as the supreme game of chance,. There are many different ways to play "Gee Wiz" each method providing a wealth of thrilling entertainment.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before running a race be certain that all horses are lined up evenly at the barrier ( starting point) and that all the flags at opposite end of track are lowered. To operate, hook loop in string over the pin in the shaft and wind by turning fly wheel away from you five or six times. Hold game down with one hand and give the string a vigorous pull toward you. This should keep the fly wheel spinning with enough power to carry all the horses the complete length of the track up to the point where the flags go up. As the horses finish the flags rise ( for instance if the white flag goes up to erect position first the white horse is the winner and the flags go up in corresponding sequence as the horses "come in." A few practice races will indicate just how hard the string should be pulled for the best action.

To line the horses up for the next race simply pass the string in front of the horses and draw them back to barrier.

All horses have an equal chance of winning because once the race starts no one can control the action of the horses. In some instances dirt or dust in the tracks will retard the forward motion of a horse. To avoid this the grooves in the tracks should be kept clean by the occasional use of a soft cloth.

A drop of lubricating oil on the bearings at each end of the fly wheel now and then is also advisable.

"Gee Wiz" should be played on an even level or surface.
